

Page ix	Table of Contents; Chapter 1: "Stroke Effects on Type" and "Totally Distressed Type Effect" moved to be first two techniques in chapter.
Page 18	"Stroke Effects on Type" technique moved to page 8 (first technique in chapter).
Page 32	"Totally Distressed Type Effect" technique moved to page 14 (second technique in chapter).
Page 60	Quick Tip; second sentence: "Shift key" should be "Command key (PC: Control key)" Quick Tip; third sentence: "open all the Shift-clicked images" should be "open all the selected images."
Page 119	Replace top fig on page with the following: 
Page 162	The small Expand Selection dialog box is correct. Step Two: Replace text with the following: Command-click (PC: Control-click) on your pill layer to select it. Create another blank layer. Then go under the Select menu, under Modify, and choose Contract. Enter 20 pixels and click OK to contract your selection. (Note: If your original pill shape is too small, the selection may not have the room to contract the 20 pixels, so you may get a warning that no pixels were selected. Try to enter a smaller number of pixels in the Contract dialog or redraw the pill shape at a larger size.) Press the letter "d" and "x" to set your Foreground color to white.

Page 192	Step One: Add text to sentence: "Open a color RGB image, and set your Foreground color to black by pressing the letter "d." Step Two: Should be "Click on the Brush tool" (replace "too" with "tool").
