# Making the Galaxy S6 More Accessible

Let's face it. As we get older, it often becomes more difficult to read fine print and sometimes to perform fine motor functions. And your phone packs a lot of things into its relatively small package. The result is that we sometimes have trouble seeing what's onscreen, or tapping where we need to tap.

Fortunately, there are several settings on the Galaxy S6/S6 Edge that can make life easier for us. These include accessibility options as well as a special Easy Mode that simplifies the phone's operation.

# Working with Easy Mode

Today's smartphones can do so many things that it's easy to get confused. With so many options available, just what things should you tap—and which should you ignore? If you have difficulty operating your phone, or if you find that the default screen icons are just too small to see or use comfortably, consider switching to Easy Mode. This mode presents a different screen layout and experience than the default mode.

#### Switch to Easy Mode

You can easily switch back and forth between Easy Mode and your phone's default mode.

- Swipe down from the top of the screen to display the notification panel.
- 2 Tap Settings to display the Settings screen.
- Scroll to the Personal section and tap Easy Mode.
- 4) Tap to select Easy Mode.





- Scroll to the Easy Applications section and tap On each of the apps you want to display in Easy Mode. You can choose to display the Camera, Email, Gallery, Messages, Music, My Files, Phone, Calendar, and Video apps. Select only those you think you'll use regularly.
- 6 Tap Done. Your phone resets itself in Easy Mode.

#### **Back to Normal**

To switch back to standard mode, select Settings, Easy Mode and then tap to select Standard Mode.

#### **Use Easy Mode**

Easy Mode displays fewer icons per screen, but the icons are larger. You see icons only for those apps you selected during the configuration process. In addition, all the onscreen text is larger, which makes it easier to see for anyone with vision difficulties.

- Swipe left or right to view additional screens.
- 2 Tap any icon to launch that application.
- 3 To remove an application from the screen, tap Edit.



4 Tap the minus sign to hide that app from the Easy Mode screen.

- 5 Tap Done when you're done hiding icons.
- 6 To view all the apps installed on your phone, even if they're hidden in Easy Mode, tap More Apps.
- 7 To add the icon for another app to the Easy Mode screen, tap one of the + icons.

If you find the onscreen text on your Galaxy S6 or S6 Edge difficult to read, you can change it. Samsung enables you to change both the font and the font size displayed for icon labels, screen headings, and the like.

# Select Screen Fonts and Sizes

- 1 Swipe down from the top of the screen to display the notification panel.
- 2 Tap Settings to display the Settings screen.
- 3 Scroll to the Device section and tap Display and Wallpaper.





# **Using Voice Feedback**

If you have trouble seeing what's on the screen, you can enable Galaxy TalkBack, which provides voice feedback when you're using your phone.

#### **Enable Galaxy TalkBack**

The Galaxy TalkBack feature reads aloud whatever is selected on the Galaxy S6 screen. When activated, your phone reads whatever is under your finger when you tap.

- 1 Swipe down from the top of the screen to display the notification panel.
- 2 Tap Settings to display the Settings screen.
- Scroll to the System section and tap Accessibility.
- 4 Tap Vision to display the Vision screen.
- **5**) Tap Galaxy TalkBack.

- Tap On the switch at the top of the screen.
- 7 Tap Turn On when you're prompted to use Galaxy TalkBack.



## Use Galaxy TalkBack

With TalkBack activated, any item you tap onscreen generates a voice telling you what that item is—and, in some instances, information about that item. For example, if you tap the Email icon when you have new messages waiting, TalkBack tells you how many new messages you have. You can also tap an open item to have TalkBack read the content of a message or document.

Because tapping an item tells you about it, with TalkBack activated you have to double-tap apps to open them or perform specific operations. In fact, most touch gestures change when you're using TalkBack, as indicated in the following table.

Gesture	Action
Тар	Reads aloud the item under your finger.
Double-tap	Opens the selected item.
Double-tap and hold	Moves an item across the screen or accesses an available option.
Swipe left	Moves to previous item.
Swipe right	Moves to next item.
Swipe up or down	Uses the most recent menu item or changes its settings. In text selection mode, moves the cursor backward or forward to select text.
Swipe left then right (in one motion)	Scrolls up the screen.
Swipe right then left (in one motion)	Scrolls down the screen.
Swipe up then down (in one motion)	Move to the first item on the screen.
Swipe down then up (in one motion)	Move to the last item on the screen.

#### **Explore the Screen**

To explore the items on the screen in TalkBack mode, simply place your finger on the screen and then move it around.

# **Configuring Visibility Options**

In addition to Galaxy TalkBack, there are several other options you can configure to make it easier to operate your phone if you have vision problems. These are detailed in the following table.

Option	Description
Voice Label	Record voice labels you can place on various items around your house, and have your phone read them back to you.
Font Size	Changes the size of onscreen fonts from Tiny to Huge.
Magnification Gestures	Zooms into or out of areas of the screen when you triple-tap the screen.
Magnifier Window	Displays a small window that magnifies the selected area of the screen. (Tap and drag to move the magnification window around the screen.)
Grayscale	Changes the phone's display from color to grayscale.
Negative Colors	Reverses the onscreen colors. (White background changes to black; black text changes to white.)
Color Adjustment	Enables adjustment of onscreen colors for better viewing.
Accessibility Shortcut	Displays accessibility options when you hold down the Power key or tap and hold the screen with two fingers.
Text-to-Speech Options	Adjusts the speed of Samsung's text-to-speech engine.

#### **Voice Label**

The Voice Label feature works in conjunction with special labels you can purchase from Samsung. You use your phone to record your voice saying what the label is affixed to; then you place the label on that item. Later, you can hover your phone over the item and its label to use your phone's NFC technology to "read" the label to you. It's a great way for people with vision impairment to better get around—and locate items in—their homes.

#### **Enable Visibility Options**

All visibility options are accessed via the Visibility screen.

- 1 Swipe down from the top of the screen to display the notification panel.
- 2 Tap Settings to display the Settings screen.
- 3 Scroll to the System section and tap Accessibility.
