167	Top of page: A Business account is necessary if you're receiving a high volume of payments. With this type of account you can do business under a corporate or group name, and use multiple logins.	A Business account is what you want if you're selling on eBay. With this type of account you can accept both non-credit card and credit card payments (for a fee).
167	Paragraph in middle of page: PayPal's fee (as of Summer 2003)...	PayPal's fees depend on how much business you do. The standard rate (as of summer 2004) for billings of less than \$3,000 per month is 2.9%. The Merchant rate for monthly billings between \$3,000 and \$10,000 drops to 2.5%; the rate for monthly billings between \$10,000 and \$100,000 is 2.2%; and the rate for monthly billings over \$100,000 is 1.9%. No matter what the billing rate, you're also charged \$0.30 for each transaction. These fees are deducted from your account with every transaction.
