**Page 194**, sidebar, Measuring In Stops, end of 1st paragraph

Text should read: "Similarly, when you change the aperture from f/8 to f/5.6, you double the amount of light that strikes the focal plane because the size (area) of the aperture at f/5.6 is twice as large as at f/8. (Obviously, moving the other direction, from 1/125 to 1/250 or from f/8 to f/11, results in halving of the light.)"
