



## Using a Photo as Wallpaper

iPhone's wallpaper appears when you wake it up but before you unlock it. You can use any photo stored on your iPhone to customize your wallpaper.

1. View the photo you want to use as wallpaper.
2. Tap the Action button.
3. Tap Use as Wallpaper.




4. Drag and pinch or unpinch the image until the part you want to use as wallpaper shows on the screen the way you want to see it.
5. Tap Set Wallpaper. The wallpaper is set, and you return to the photo.
6. Tap the Sleep/Wake button to put iPhone to sleep and lock it.
7. Tap the Sleep/Wake button again. You see your custom wallpaper.


