Project Gutenberg is unlike other e-book stores. You won't find the latest releases, but if you want books that have stood the test of time like *The Three Musketeers*, *Alice in Wonderland*, or *The Jungle Book*, you can get them for free. Unlike the other e-book sites, you don't need a Project Gutenberg app; you just need iBooks or the Kindle app.

Downloading E-books from Project Gutenberg

To get books from Project Gutenberg, tap Safari to open it and then follow these steps:

1. Go to <http://www.gutenberg.org/>.
2. Tap the search box and type the name of the book or writer you're looking for and tap Go. To browse the collection, tap Catalog.
3. On the results page, find the book you're looking for and tap its title.

- To get a version that works in iBooks, tap EPUB. To get one that works with the Kindle app, tap Kindle.
- If you tap EPUB, a screen asks what app you want to read the book in. Tap the Open in "iBooks" button.

Downloading for Kindle

If you tap Kindle, you'll get asked where you want to open the book. Tap the Open in "Kindle" button.

- The book will download to iBooks or Kindle. In iBooks, it will open for you to begin reading. In Kindle, tap it to start reading.
