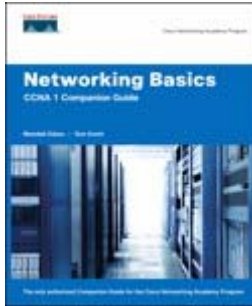


Instructor Comments on the New CCNA 1 Companion Guide
