

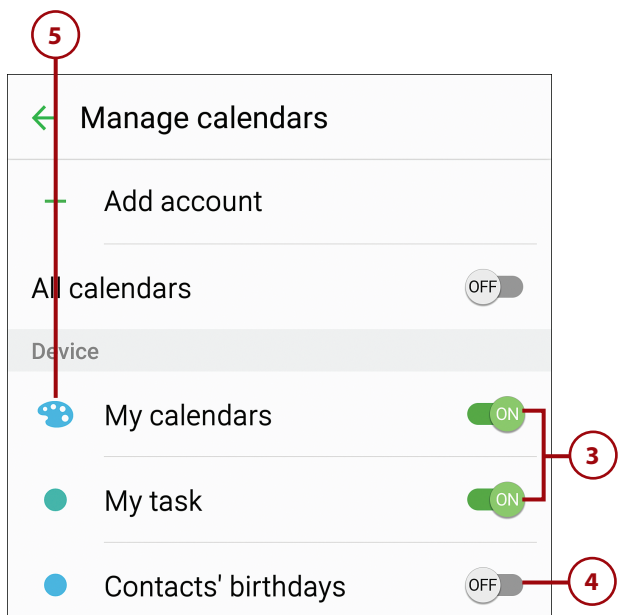
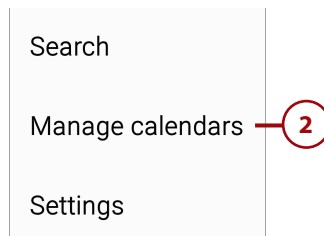
Personalizing Your Calendar

Most people find the Calendar app quite useful as is. You can, however, customize it to your personal tastes.

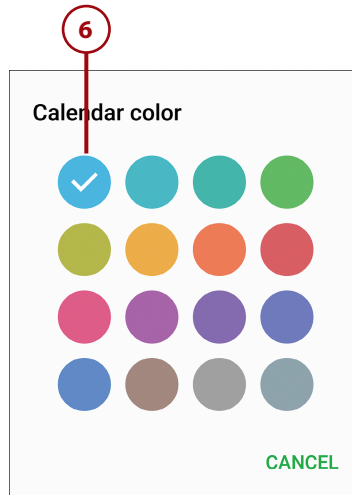
Configure Calendar Settings

There are several settings within the Calendar app that you can configure. You can, for example, change the colors used to display certain events or choose to display your friends' birthdays.

- 1 From any calendar screen, tap More.
- 2 Tap Manage Calendars.
- 3 By default, the Calendars app displays your calendars and tasks. To turn off either of these options, tap Off the appropriate switch.
- 4 Tap the Contacts' Birthdays switch to display your contacts' birthdays on your calendar.
- 5 Tap the color palette icon next to My Calendars to change the default color of events in your calendar.



6 Tap the desired color.

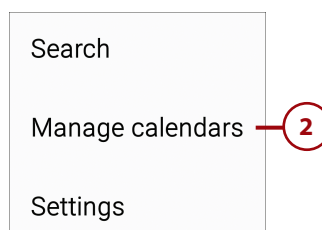


Activate Gmail Calendars

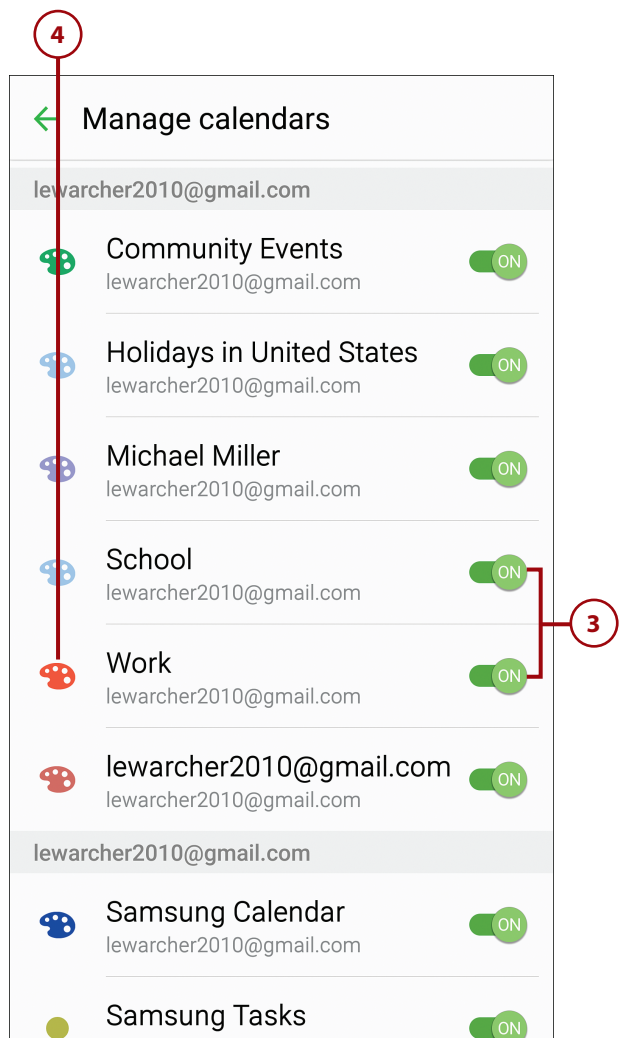
The Calendar app links to Google Calendar. Events you add in Google Calendar automatically appear in the Calendar app. If you have multiple Google Calendars (one for work, say, and another for home) you can opt to display any and all of these calendars in the Calendar app.

1 From any calendar screen, tap More.

2 Tap Manage Calendars.



- 3 Tap On each calendar you want to display.
- 4 Tap the color palette icon for a given calendar to change the color for events from that calendar.



5 Tap the desired color.
